The subject of this Lecture is the grant of injunctions by the English Courts in relation to arbitration. Two quite different situations are considered; the first where there is an application to the court for an injunction to restrain an arbitration, either in England or abroad - an "anti-arbitration" injunction; the second where there is an application to the Court for an injunction to restrain court proceedings in favour of the dispute being resolved by arbitration - an "anti-suit" injunction. Although quite different in their intended effect, both situations raise similar legal and policy considerations. The lecture will highlight those considerations and identify common themes.

Graham Dunning QC, a leading commercial Silk experienced in arbitration both as counsel and as arbitrator (including arbitrations under the ICC, UNCITRAL, LCIA and LMAA Rules) examines recent cases in this fast moving area of arbitration and considers whether the line adopted by the English courts is to be commended and what the future holds.
